RE: OMB Memorandum Pausing Federal Financial Assistance (M-25-13)

Dear Mr. Vaeth:

The Disability & Rehabilitation Research Coalition (DRRC) is deeply concerned by the memorandum distributed by your office on January 27, 2025, directing all federal agencies to pause Federal financial assistance for many programs and activities that are essential for people with disabilities, including significant investments in rehabilitation and disability research.

The DRRC is a coalition of 26 national research, clinical, and consumer non-profit organizations committed to improving the science of disability, independent living, and rehabilitation. The DRRC seeks to maximize the return on the federal research investment in these areas with the goal of improving the ability of Americans with disabilities to live and function as independently as possible following an injury, illness, disability, or chronic condition.

Since our coalition's inception in 2008, we have closely monitored and supported federal appropriations to rehabilitation and disability research programs to raise the return on investment for individuals living with disabilities and chronic conditions. We are dismayed to learn hard-won progress in research may be delayed by the mandated freeze and subsequent comprehensive analysis of programs. We are further concerned that many agencies and programs do not yet have political appointees to conduct the required analyses of Federal financial assistance. We ask that your office provide more information to the American people on the programs whose funds are now frozen, a detailed timeline for resuming funding, and more information on the political appointees who will be leading these program analyses.
